## **DOG FOULING & LITTER IN CHURCH STRETTON**

## Our Model Action Plan...a probable approach.

- 1. BUILD A CONSENSUS...SC, TC, CPRE, PUBLIC PROTECTION, STREET SCENE, PRIDE OF PLACE, SPORTS CLUBS, SCHOOLS, SHOPKEEPERS, Chamber of Trade, CSCG, Mayfair, Walkers are Welcome, Rectory Wood & Field Interest Group: other organisations Ramblers, Rambling Group, Scouts, W4H, Wildlife Trust, Police.
- 2. ENGAGE THE PUBLIC...Ask people & listen to them...only promise what can be delivered...get local public on board. Gazebo demonstrations in Square: hold a public meeting to explain the Plan before June?
- 3. WHERE?...Define specific areas (ideally where control is possible). These areas should be identified & agreed. Football field and Rectory Field? Beaumont Road?
- 4. WHEN?...Set dates for a <u>six week campaign</u> June/July -split into three two-week sessions. Ensure others are able & willing to assist. <u>Start lightly</u>... Use traffic light sequence each of 2 weeks duration.
  - (a) Green...Polite Introduction -Please Pick Up...Please Bin It...Please Keep Our Space Safe
  - (b) Amber...Because Poo is Dirty, It's Not Fair, It's Messy, You Are Letting Us Down
  - (c) Red... Or Else You Will Be Caught, You Will Be Fined, Named & Shamed?
    First two weeks <u>publicise</u> the Action Campaign;
    next two weeks <u>warn</u> locals but resist becoming heavy-handed;
    last two weeks use the law & <u>enforce</u> it by issuing offenders with ECRs
- 5. HOW?...Explain the Action Plan...with posters, at a public meeting, gazebo displays, local press, radio & TV...
  - Involve primary school in poster design (using Green 'Please'; Amber 'Because'; Red 'Or Else').
  - Select & laminate chosen posters...Tell parents & try to get them on board. Display posters
- 6. DEEP CLEAN...Select one grot spot area and deep clean it with, if possible, a synchronised clean-up of both litter & dog fouling. Rectory Field &/or Brooksbury Recreation Ground? Equipment needed and publicity. Gloves, poo bags, litter pickers, poo pickers & bags, spray paints, hi-vis vests.
  - People to become aware of the difference: before & after.
- 7. ORGANISE REGULAR PATROLS...to identify & mark all new deposits. Once daily as a minimum? Volunteers & officers? Dog warden(s) including Church Stretton's. Record new fouling & paint spray each deposit...use different daily colours to show that notice is being taken...narrow the time of day when deposits are appearing. Try to witness depositing & report to StreetScene/dog warden/public protection. Try to register and train volunteers to be able to issue ECRs to offenders.
- 8. **OFFENDERS**...the thoughtless majority and the <u>mindless minority</u>. This latter group don't seem to care; they are often known & disliked by responsible dog owners: target these! The Action Plan should have got the thoughtless on board... & the mindless offenders should now be isolated, recognised, identified and dealt with.
