**Coppice venue:** Park at [Harton Hollow Reserve](#) car park, Westhope (see map on p2). The site is on the Wenlock Edge ridge North of Westhope, 6 miles NE of Craven Arms.

**Arrival time:** Please arrive by 9.45 for the prompt 10am start. The workshop will go on until around 4pm. On the first day please meet in the main carpark (see map).

**Equipment:** Richard will provide all the equipment you will need on the day (gloves, safety goggles, hand tools), but you are welcome to bring your own thick gardening gloves.

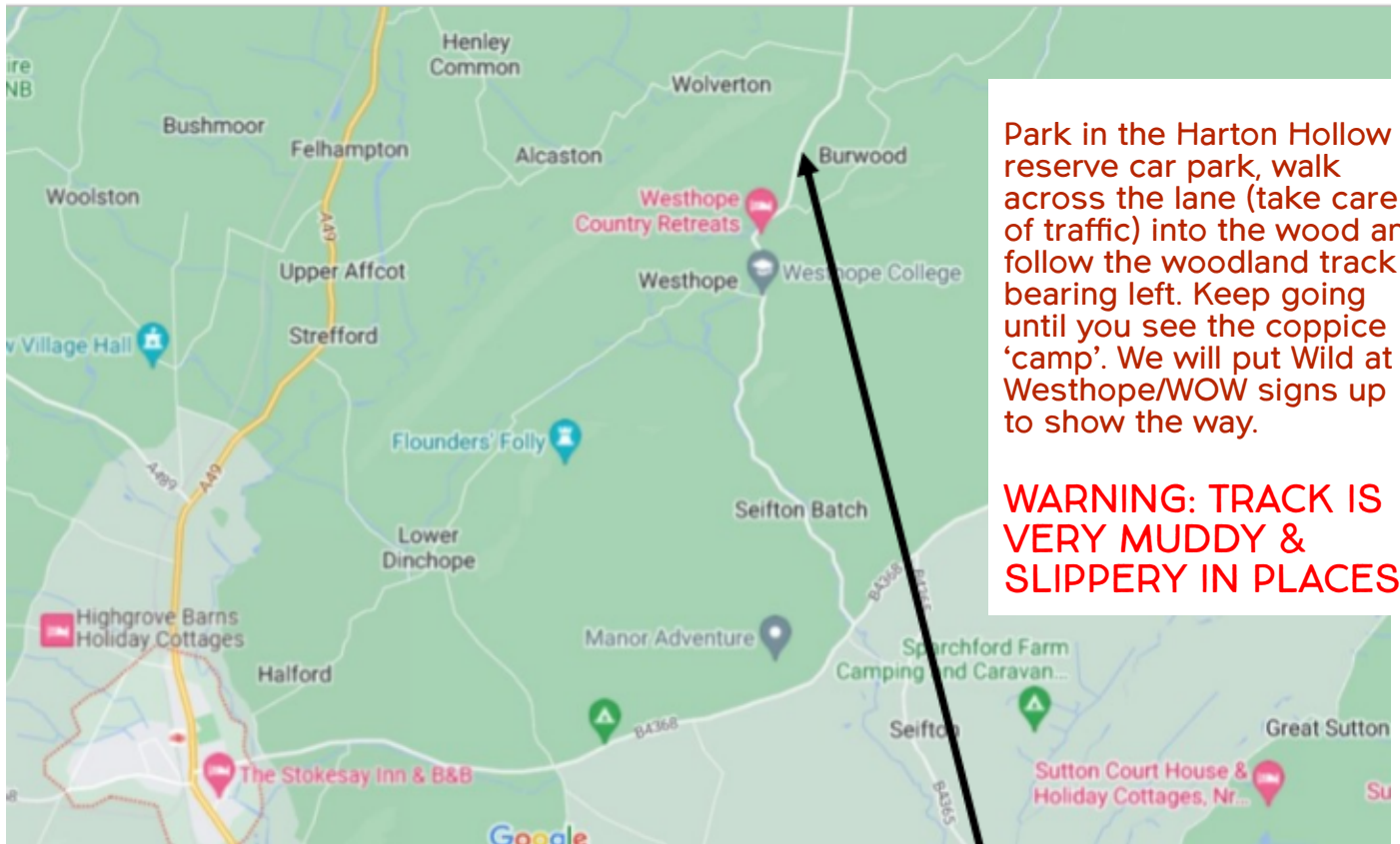
This workshop is part of CPRE Shropshire's Hedgerow Project 2023-24

## Parking: Harton Hollow Reserve car park, Westhope

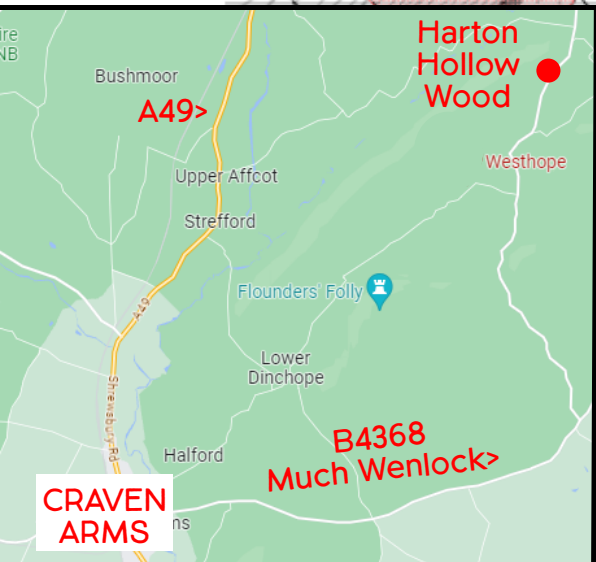
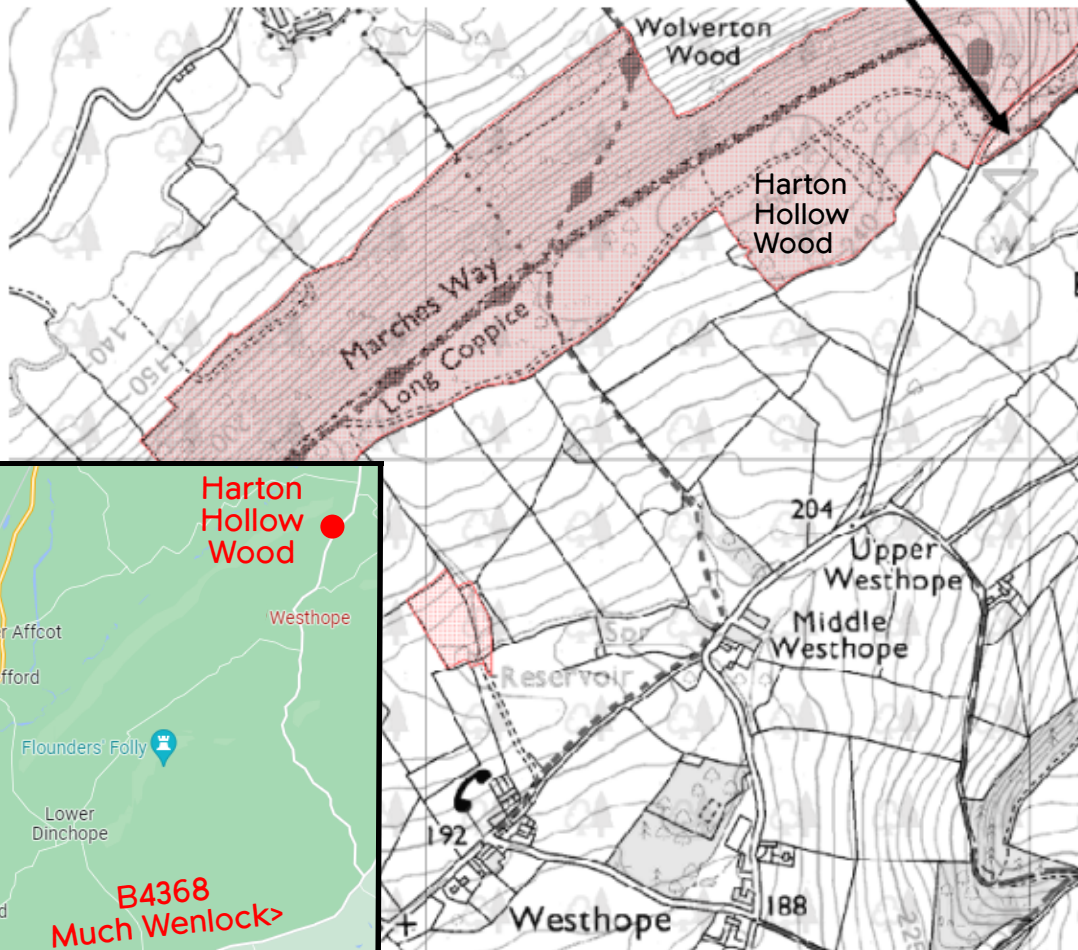
